THE PASSING OF THE PEACE

Lift up your hearts! We lift them up to the LORD!

Let us give thanks to the LORD our God. It is right to give him thanks and praise.

The peace of the Lord Jesus Christ be always with you. And also with you.

At this time we leave the comfort of our seat, turn to our neighbors, and formally or informally communicate the words, "The peace of the Lord be with you" and receive the words in turn, "And also with you."

PARENTS: Kids Table (ages 4-10) is open for your children to attend during the sermon portion of the service and Nursery (ages 0-4) is available throughout the entirety of the service. Both are in the lower level. We also have a nursing mother's room located near the front entrance, and a live stream of the service in the downstairs hallway where parents can bring children who need additional attention or space to quiet.

HIS WORD TASTES OF GRACE

OLD TESTAMENT READING Leviticus 2: 11-13, Isaiah 42: 5-7

¹¹ "No grain offering that you bring to the Lord shall be made with leaven, for you shall burn no leaven nor any honey as a food offering to the Lord. ¹² As an offering of firstfruits you may bring them to the Lord, but they shall not be offered on the altar for a pleasing aroma. ¹³ You shall season all your grain offerings with salt. You shall not let the salt of the covenant with your God be missing from your grain offering; with all your offerings you shall offer salt.

⁵ Thus says God, the Lord,

who created the heavens and stretched them out, who spread out the earth and what comes from it,
who gives breath to the people on it and spirit to those who walk in it:

Applying The Gospel of Matthew

YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

Take some time to meditate on the ways in which Christ has preserved you and prevent you from receiving the penalty of sin and death. Offer thanksgiving and praise to God.

How do you see the salt of Christ impacting places where you go? How are you tempted in those places to either want to withdraw or change as a result of the environment.

YOU ARE THE LIGHT OF THE WORLD

In your home and in your relationships, are you allowing other Christians to shine a light on your sin? Are you pointing people to the only remedy for their sin in addition to seeing their sin?

Take a walk this week specifically with the mindset of being Christ's salt of the earth and light of the world. Pray he would show you places, people and possibilities to offer hope to those who dwell in darkness.

Scripture for Meditation: Matthew 5:16

let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

READ - (lectio)

Read the passage slowly. Then read the passage again asking the Spirit to highlight a word or phrase from the passage. Do not choose the word of phrase for yourself. Take the time to allow the Holy Spirit to lead you to it and welcome what He brings with meekness (a willingness) and thankfulness.

REFLECT - (meditatio)

Read the passage again slowly. Reflect on the word or phrase that stood out to you. Why does this word or phrase resonate with you. Ask God: how does this connect with my life today? What do I need to know or be or do?

RESPOND/PRAY - (oratio)

Read the passage one final time. Prepare yourself for what you want to say to God about what the Holy Spirit brought to you. Pray in whatever way you are led - in exaltation, contrition, thanksgiving, or petition.

REST - (contemplatio)

Be with God. Wait upon Him. Rest in Him. Sit in companionship with Him - the God who seeks you, delights in you and is, in Christ, smiling over you.
